Cathedral High School is committed to providing a school environment free from harassment in any form. Cathedral's sports teams are an important and integral part of school life and all students playing on a team are to support one another and not engage in any activity that infringes on the safety or well-being of another player (student). For this reason, bullying and/or hazing can immediately be dismissed from the school.

Preventing bullying/hazing is the responsibility of all players and coaches and everyone can help. Not saying anything while you observe others engaged in harassing others is also wrong. Silence condones these activities and can make the observer also responsible.

I understand it is my responsibility as a player (student) not to engage in bullying/hazing and not to be silent if I observe bullying or hazing and to report such activity both to my coach and Ms. Ruiz, Dean of Students by the next school day.

A few examples of bullying/hazing that are NOT permitted and need to be reported include:

- Physically touching, pushing, poking, grabbing or hitting, another student against his will.
- Doing things that endanger the physical or mental health of another student (i.e. causing indecent exposure or nudity, demeaning or racist comments, etc.).
- Forcing a student to do something he does not want to do (i.e. eating or drinking something, forcing someone into a shower or locker, etc.).

Be proud to be a Phantom and act accordingly. If you see something that is wrong step up and stop it and say something because that is what true Phantoms do.

I understand my responsibility as a player is not to engage in bullying/hazing and if I see any bullying/hazing to report it to my coach AND Ms. Ruiz, Dean of Students.
